- 1. Opening prayer was led by Steve Wilkinson.

- 3. Minutes of last meeting 17th May 2017 were agreed.
- 4. Matters arising not covered on agenda

- 5. Benefice Update
 - a. Reports from Brinkworth and Great Somerford Parishes
 - i. Brinkworth Stephen reported that the bells are now likely to back in place by October. Cleaning work had also taken place in the Bell Tower in anticipation of their
 - ii. Great Somerford Richard reported on a very successful Garden Fete. Chancel Pews had also been removed and some very attractive Victorian Floor Tiles had been revealed

He will be reflecting on all this.
 - e. Living Churchyards and Churchyard Regulations Steve thought that all PCCs had agreed to the revised guidelines in principle. He would now finalise documents subject to previously suggested amendments. Action Point 3

The Synod also passed a motion calling for a review of the rules concerning the storage and possible disposal of valuable items.
